**2008 Student Scholarship**

Each year the California Park and Recreation Society's District II is pleased to provide scholarship awards to students or graduates who have shown outstanding achievements and professional potential in the field of parks and recreation.

**Three awards are available:**

**Edwin L. Z'berg Memorial Student Award**  
\$1000 and 1 year CPRS membership

**Arvid Pauly Student Award**  
\$500 and 1 year CPRS membership

**Park Maintenance & Operations Award**  
\$1000 and 1 year CPRS membership

**Edwin L. Z'berg Award**

- Must be a student at a community college, within the District II boundaries with 30 completed units, including 15 completed units in recreation, leisure studies, or a related field; or
- Of junior standing at a college within the District II boundaries and majoring in the field of Recreation/Leisure Studies and have completed 60 semester or 90 quarter units by the fall of 2007; or
- Enrolled in a Master's program at a college within the District II boundaries

**Arvid Pauly Award**

- Must be a student at a college within the District II boundaries and majoring in the field of Recreation and Leisure Studies.

**Park Maintenance & Operations Award**

- Must be a student at a community college, within the District II boundaries with 30 completed units, including 15 completed units in park maintenance and operations, or a related field; or
- Of junior standing at a college within the District II boundaries and majoring in the field of Recreation and Park Management and have completed 60 semester or 90 quarter units by the fall of 2008; or
- Enrolled in a Master's program at a college within the District II boundaries

**Application Requirements**

- Complete one application for each award.
- Each applicant may only receive one award.
- Applications available from Barry Trute by calling (916) 653-3495.
- Applications must be received by December 5, 2008, at 5:00p.m.
- Include proof of enrollment in a Community College, State College, or University that is within the District II boundaries.
- Include a copy of unofficial college transcripts.
- Include narrative of why you should receive a scholarship award (max. 3 pages).
- Be available to participate in the scholarship interview in January 2009.
- Be available to participate in the presentation at the CPRS District II Awards and Installation Banquet on March 20, 2009 (Location: California State University, Sacramento Alumni Center).

**Award Determination**

A review panel comprised of Park, Recreation, Leisure Services, and Education Professionals will review each application. The panel will conduct interviews with the candidates and recommend award winners. These recommendations are forwarded to the CPRS District II Board Members for review and approval. All decisions by the Board are final.
